DIRECTIONS: Control common insects and diseases on roses, flowers, and common garden ornamentals before they damage your plants. Keep plants, particularly new growth and upper and lower leaf surfaces, protected throughout the growing season with a light uniform coating. Start early for disease protection and repeat at regular 7 to 10 day intervals. The best time to apply is early morning or evening when the air is still. Do not apply when temperature is 24°C or higher. Avoid dusting open blooms.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: Aphids, Caterpillars, Leafhoppers, Leafrollers, Rose Slugs, Rose Chafers, Japanese Beetles, Spider Mites, Mealybugs, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Thrips, Leafminers.

DISEASES CONTROLLED: Black Spot, Leaf Spot, Powdery and Downy Mildew, Rust.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Hazardous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust and contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not contaminate feed or food. Do not use on food crops. Poisonous to bees-avoid application to flower blossoms.

FIRST AID: Malathion and carbaryl are cholinesterase inhibitors. Atropine is antidotal. If swallowed, induce vomiting and obtain medical attention. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with clean water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of container in regular garbage.
