GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Zodiac Flea & Tick Powder has been developed to control Brown Dog and American Dog ticks on dogs and cats. It is also effective against fleas on dogs and cats.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Do NOT administer by mouth. Use only in well-ventilated areas, preferably outdoors. Dust powder over the animal and rub thoroughly into the skin. Be sure to thoroughly treat the feet, legs and between toes. Do not treat mouth, eyes, face or genitals. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment. Do not use this powder more often than once every week. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem reoccurs. Do NOT use on sick or nursing animals, on animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment, or on dogs or cats under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using on aged or pregnant animals. Do NOT use this product at the same time or within 30 days before or after treatment with, or exposure, to other cholinesterase-inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. For Kennels, Dog Houses and Sleeping Pads: Remove and clean or destroy old bedding materials. Thoroughly wash quarters with detergent and water, then allow to dry. Dust powder in and around sleeping quarters and other areas where ticks and fleas may hide.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet should be combined with sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, an insecticidal treatment of the premises may be required (Zodiac Premise Plus, Zodiac Premise 1000/2000). A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation continues to be a problem on the pet.
