DIRECTIONS

To kill flying insects (mosquitoes, flies, biting midge, drosophila, wasps):

Close doors and windows. Shut off all ventilating systems. Prevent persons and animals from entering area. Using a fogger or pressurized sprayer, direct mist upwards to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Apply at a rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 10 m³. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 10-15 min. after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1 m from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate for 1 hour before reentry. Sweep up and destroy dead insects.

To kill crawling insects (cockroaches, silverfish, spiders, ants): Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails around door sills, window frames or in ant nests. Insects must be contacted to be killed. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated. Sweep up and destroy dead insects.

Food Processing Plants and Food Service Establishments: In food processing plants and food service establishments, apply only when plant is not in operation. Remove all food before treatment. Cover all food processing surfaces and clean them thoroughly with potable water before resuming operation.

NOTICE TO USER:

This control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on this label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing and inhalation of spray mist. Wash after use. Do not remain in treated areas. Do not spray directly on food or utensils. Cover fishbowls and remove bird cages and pets for one hour when spraying. Do not spray closer than 1 m to fabric. Remove or cover all exposed food and cooking utensils before spraying. Any treated surface that may contact food or feed products should be washed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before re-use. Product toxic to fish. Do not contaminate any body of water. This product contains petroleum distillate. Do not store, pour or use near open flame. Wear mask or respirator and protective clothing when applying spray mist.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Follow provincial guidelines for any required cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make empty container unsuitable for further use and dispose of in

accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency, or the manufacturer.
