DIRECTIONS:

Later's Hybor-D Soil Sterilant is a non-corrosive, non-flammable, ready-to-use granular material to control weeds and grasses in areas where vegetation is not wanted. It is low in toxicity to humans and animals. Apply the required amount of Later's Hybor-D evenly to the area to be treated. For best results, application should be made in early spring when weeds are just starting to grow. Application made in late spring and summer may be slow to show results. This material is best applied just prior to rainfall since moisture is required to carry the chemicals to the root zone on the plants. If rain is not expected, then watering the area after application will help. Hybor-D could persist in the soil for a period of up to 2 years.

1 m = approx. 1 long pace  
10 m<sup>2</sup> = 5 m x 2 m

HOW TO USE: For control of annual and shallow rooted perennial weeds and grasses, sprinkle 500 g over 10 m<sup>2</sup>. For hard to kill deep rooted perennials, use 750 g per 10 m<sup>2</sup>. Apply evenly over area to be treated and water in.

For spot treating weeds and grasses growing through asphalt and concrete driveways and sidewalks, sprinkle Later's Hybor-D at the base of the weeds where they are growing through the pavement. Then sprinkle with enough water to wet the area, but not too much or the chemical will be washed away.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation, swallowing or skin contact. Wash hands after handling. Protective Clothing: Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves.

Operator Use Precautions: Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Re-use gloves for pesticide application only.

Re-entry Interval: Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until dust has settled.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Later's Hybor-D should be kept away from all desirable plants, shrubs, trees or grasses. TAKE CARE THAT ROOTS OF DESIRABLE PLANTS DO NOT PENETRATE INTO TREATED AREAS OR INJURY MAY RESULT. THIS MATERIAL MAY BE LEACHED DOWN SLOPING LAND BY RAINFALL. Avoid contamination of irrigation or domestic water sources.

#### FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED, cause vomiting to clear stomach. Give lime water, milk of magnesia or 1% solution of calcium chloride. Contact a doctor or poison control centre at once.

IF IN EYES, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN, wash with soap and water.

STORAGE: Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place away from food, feed, seeds, fertilizer, insecticides or fungicides.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use container. Wrap container in newspaper

and dispose of in regular garbage.
