2.4 g = 1 teaspoon

VEGETABLES: For control of cutworms apply if damage is expected. Use on broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, Chinese cabbage, cauliflower, carrots, celery, cucumbers, green peppers, onions, potatoes, sweet corn and tomatoes. Apply dust to soil around plant at a rate of 70 g per 10 m of row. Do not use on green bunching onions. For control of potato flea beetle and tarnished plant bug on potatoes apply dust to plant at a rate of 35 g per 10 m of row. Repeat weekly as needed. Do not make more than nine applications during one season.

LAWNS: To control White Grubs and the grubs of the European Chafer and Japanese Beetle, apply 425 g per 10 m2. Apply in late July or August when grubs are small and are feeding on the grass roots just below the soil surface. Immediately after dusting, water the lawn thoroughly. To control Chinch Bugs and Ants, apply 225 g per 10 m2 of lawn at the first sign of damage and repeat as required. Water thoroughly and keep off until dry. Treat ant nest & trails.

ORNAMENTAL PLANTS & SHRUBS: Soil Treatment - To control Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Sowbugs, Spiders, Cutworms, White Grubs, European Chafer Larvae, and Japanese Beetle Larvae. Dust turf or soil around plants to give good coverage. Apply 425 g per 10 m2. Make no more than 2 applications per season.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS: Foliar treatment - To control Aphids, Mites, Scales, Spittlebugs, Thrips and Whiteflies, dust plant lightly to give uniform coverage of upper and lower surfaces of leaves.

HOUSE PLANTS: If possible remove plants outside for treatment. For soil insects, apply dust lightly to soil around plant. For foliar insects, thoroughly cover leaf surfaces. Repeat as needed - no more than once every 2 months.
