THIS CONTAINER CAN BE REFILLED USING THE "JRS FILLER" USE ONLY THE JAAB PLANT INSECT KILLER BULK REFILL (REG. NO. 25844 PCP ACT). FOLLOW REFILL INSTRUCTIONS ON BULK REFILL LABEL.

NON-GAS AEROSOL, Delivers a quiet, even spray without using CFC or hydrocarbon propellents. All net contents are available for use, unlike a normal aerosol where a large percentage is propellant that is lost to the atmosphere and serves no other purpose than propelling product from the container.

Container can be held in any position, even upside down to spray insects in the most difficult to reach areas, such as the underside of leaves, where the insects hide.

TO KILL INDOOR PESTS:

Pests on Ornamental Plants: For control of Aphids, Two-spotted Spider Mites, Mealybugs and Adult Whiteflies on the following plants: African Violets, Aralia, Christmas Cherry, Chrysanthemum, Cineraria, Dieffenbachia, Fuchsia, Gloxinia, Ivy, Lantana, Neanthe Bella Palm, Petunia, Rose & Snapdragon. Spray when insects are noticed with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts on upper and lower leaf surface. Use with caution on new growth and tender foliage, Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS ON OUTDOOR FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS. Sucking Insects: Exposed Thrips, Leafhoppers, Spider Mites. Lacebugs, Aphids. Chewing Insects: Caterpillars. Climbing Cutworms, Japanese Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles. Mealybugs, Soft brown scale, Tent Caterpillars, Cankerworms & Garden Webworms on Ornamental Crabapple, Cherries & Plum Tree. For insects on Asters. Azaleas, Begonias. Carnations, Camellias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Geraniums, Gladiolas, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses, and Snapdragons, Evergreens, small Deciduous trees, shrubs and vines: Carefully spray with slow sweeping motion in short bursts at intervals to cover upper and lower surfaces of leaves. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32EC. Do not spray in direct sunlight (direct sunlight will inactivate pyrethrins) - early morning or evening preferred, Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

ON VEGETABLES: For insects on cabbage, carrots, tomatoes, potatoes, broccoli, onions, cucumbers. turnip, lettuce, squash, fruit trees & grapevines, Do not spray fruits and vegetables within one day of harvest.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, with eyes or skin, flush with water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed. call a Poison Control Centre & obtain medical attention at once.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not heat, puncture or incinerate container. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Avoid contact with skin. eyes, clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maiden Hair ferns.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty and refill is not desired,

press button to release all pressure then dispose of in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
