DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Read the Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

LIMITATIONS:

Do not apply directly as is to crops.

PRECAUTIONS:

Keep out of reach of unauthorized personnel

Wash with plenty of soap and water. Consult a physician if irritation develops or contact a poison control centre.

STORAGE:

Keep in original container during storage.

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from seed, fertilizer or other pesticides at temperatures below 30°C.

Protect from freezing.

Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.

Keep free of moisture in tightly sealed container.

For spills, wear appropriate safety equipment. Absorb spilled product with inert substance such as sawdust or sand. Wash spill area with a detergent solution.
