DIRECTIONS:

Apply insecticide dust using a duster or shaker device.

Potatoes: To control Colorado potato beetles, flea beetles and leafhoppers, apply a light even coating on upper and lower leaf surfaces. For larger areas, apply 225 grams/100 square meters to control Colorado potato beetle and 450 grams/100 square meters to control flea beetles and leafhoppers. If necessary, repeat treatment at 7 - 10 day intervals.

Cucumbers And Squash: To control cucumber beetles, squash bugs

and flea beetles, dust upper and lower leaf surfaces evenly. For larger areas use 275 - 450 grams/100 square meters. If necessary, repeat at 7 - 10 day intervals.

Beans: To control Mexican bean beetle, leafhoppers and flea beetles, dust upper and lower leaf surfaces evenly. For larger areas use 225 - 450 grams/100 square meters. Repeat in 10 - 14 days as needed.

Sweet Corn:

Corn Borer: Make first application when egg masses on leaves are in black-head stage. Apply evenly on upper and lower leaf surfaces. A minimum of 4 applications are required at 4 - 5 day intervals. For larger areas, apply 450 - 675 grams/100 square meters.

Corn Earworm: Dust leaves and ears thoroughly and evenly at 2 - 3 day intervals starting at first silking and continuing until silks start drying. For larger areas apply 450-675 grams /100 square meters. Three or more applications are necessary depending upon the length of silking and the severity of the infestation.

*There is no danger of residue in cattle which eat treated corn.

TOMATOES: To control flea beetles, fall armyworm, stink bugs, tomato fruitworm and tomato hornworm, apply a light even coating to upper and lower leaf surfaces. For larger areas use 225-325 grams/100 square meters. Repeat at 7 - 10 clay intervals as needed.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. This product is toxic to bees. AVOID USING DURING FLOWERING PERIOD OF THE CROP. Do not breathe dust or take internally. Avoid skin contact. Change clothing after use.
