FIRST AID

least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Call a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing before reuse. Destroy contaminated shoes. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air if effects occur. Consult a physician.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

The decision of whether to induce vomiting or not should be made by an attending physician. If lavage is performed, suggest endotracheal and/or esophageal control. Danger from lung aspiration must be weighed against toxicity when considering emptying the stomach. Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate degree of exposure (baseline data are useful). Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as Pralidoxime Chloride, may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In case of severe acute poisoning, use antidote immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, crustaceans and birds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
