Open dispenser box at side. Unwind approximately 8 cm (3 inches) of tape and reclose the dispenser box.

Tape is now ready for use and can be cut or torn to size as required.

SLUG BAIT TAPE

SLUG BAIT TAPE is an easy to use continuous barrier effective against slugs and snails. Resistant to weathering, SLUG BAIT TAPE provides long lasting protection for all plants and crops.

SLUG BAIT TAPE can be laid in or on the soil and because the bait is sandwiched between layers of paper, it is clean and safe to handle, is formulated to be less attractive to pets and wildlife and is not washed out by rain. In dry conditions watering is recommended to encourage slugs to feed.

The tape is easily applied in long or short lengths around individual plants or along rows of seedlings or growing crops. Slugs and snails eat holes in the tape so that it is possible to see exactly where infestations are heaviest and extra lengths can then be used as required. Conversely, no tape need be wasted because uneaten tape can be taken up and re-laid to protect plants in other areas of the garden. Any residues of tape can be hoed into the ground where they will continue to work until eaten by slugs or completely rotted away.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Lay strips of tape in close contact with the ground alongside plants and crops to be protected. Special plants can be protected by encircling the plant with strips of tape.
2. Anchor tape at intervals with stones or earth to hold in position. In dry conditions, water the tape and ground for best results. REMEMBER: SLUG BAIT TAPE WORKS BEST WHEN THE TAPE IS DAMP.
3. Leave SLUG BAIT TAPE in position. It remains active for many weeks under all weather conditions, but new tape is

obviously the most effective control in areas of high infestation.

4. Check tape regularly and renew tape eaten by slugs and snails. Uneaten tape can be taken up and reused as required.
