DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To be used only in the manufacture of a rodenticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Vitamin K1, in the form of intravenous, intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.
