NATURA FLEA AND TICK COLLAR FOR DOGS

PRECAUTIONS: DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY WITH COLLAR. Before use on pregnant, lactating or sick animals or on animals under drug or other pesticide treatment, consult a veterinarian. Do not use on puppies under 8 weeks of age. Remove at first sign of irritation or adverse reaction and shampoo the animal with a non-pesticidal shampoo. If reactions persist, consult a veterinarian.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: TO RID DOGS OF FLEAS AND AMERICAN AND BROWN DOG TICKS, place the collar around the dog's neck, buckle, cut off excess length and discard in garbage. When attaching to

young puppies of breeds that grow rapidly, leave excess length attached (depending on breed) to permit adjustment as the puppy grows. The collar must be worn loosely so that two fingers can be placed between the collar and the dog's neck. Activity against fleas starts within 24 hours, reaches maximum effectiveness in one week and continues up to 90 days. Ticks are relatively harder to kill and die more slowly. Activity against ticks will occur within a few days. On long-haired dogs, aids in control of ticks. Replace collar when effectiveness diminishes. The collar should be removed before bathing. For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet must be combined with cleanup and sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty pouch, box or collar. Wrap in newspaper and put in garbage collection.
