PRECAUTIONS

MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED

HARMFUL IF ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN

DANGER - EYE IRRITANT

MAY CAUSE SKIN IRRITATION

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear impervious gloves and chemical worker's goggles when handling. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing promptly and wash before reuse. Destroy contaminated shoes and leather articles. Avoid breathing vapours. Handle concentrate in a ventilated area.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call physician or poison control centre and/or transport to emergency facility immediately.

If in eyes: Flush with flowing water immediately and continuously for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air if effects occur. Get medical attention.

If on skin: Flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash clothing before reuse and destroy contaminated shoes.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Eyes: May cause eye irritation. May cause corneal injury or burn. Stain for evidence of corneal injury. If cornea is burned, instill antibiotic steroid preparation frequently. Consult ophthalmologist.

Skin: A single prolonged exposure may result in the material being absorbed in acutely toxic amounts. Chronic low grade exposure may result in illness. Prolonged or repeated exposure may cause skin irritation.

Respiratory: Vapours or mists may be toxic if produced.

Oral: May cause reaction similar to petroleum or petroleum-like solvent. If lavage is performed, suggest endotracheal and/or oesophagoscopy control. Danger from chemical pneumonia must be weighed against toxicity when considering emptying the stomach.

Systemic: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate degree of exposure (baseline data are useful). Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as pralidoxime chloride, may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In case of severe acute poisoning, use antidotes immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, crustaceans and birds. Direct contamination of any body of water with this product may kill fish. Do not contaminate any body of water by direct application, cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE

Keep in original container during storage. Store in a cool, dry well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
