On irrigated or watered areas where weeds are not under drought stress and hard to kill, apply any time. Application during droughts or when weeds are under stress will result in poorer control. Do not water turf within 24 hours of application. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns. Wait until after the third mowing. Grass seed can be safety sown 1 - 2 weeks after application at recommended rate.
