# WATER PURIFICATION:

A PH of 7.2 to 7.6 is acceptable. Add muriatic acid if HIGH. Add soda ash if LOW.

WADING POOLS:

Add 5 m1 of SPARKLE-UP for every 250 litres of water daily.
