Wilson's Pruning Paint is a fast, easy and effective sealing compound for protecting pruned, grafted or damaged trees, shrubs and roses. It prevents excessive sap flow, is a barrier to wood boring insects and wood rotting diseases. Also useful for waterproofing planter boxes, pots, tubs, etc.

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Trim rough edges off cuts and wounds with sharp knife before spraying. Treat all pruning cuts on roses and shrubs 1/2 cm or more in diameter, and on trees 1 cm or more in diameter.

Shake well, remove cap, hold can upright with valve pointing toward surface to be sprayed and about 30 cm away. Spray to uniformly cover the entire surface. Use with caution around buildings and fences to avoid staining.

PRECAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Flammable. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Do not use or store near heat, open flames, sparks or at temperatures about 50EC. Use under well ventilated conditions.

FIRST AID: Contains petroleum distillates. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting: call Physician immediately. If patient is unconscious, give him air.
