Initial shock dosages of 75 to 150 ppm Dearcide 717 are recommended to control bacterial slimes and algae encountered in recirculating cooling water systems. After control is evident, dosage may be reduced to 50 to 100 ppm or applied less frequency. See Product Bulletin 52-717 for additional information.
