DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 300 mL of ALGECIDE 7.5 per 10 000 L of pool water.
2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 150 mL per 10 000 L.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 670 mL of ALGECIDE 7.5 per 10 000 L.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Harmful if swallowed.
- Do not mix with any other chemical.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Rinse container thoroughly before discarding.
- Do not re-use.
- To dispose of chemical, flush into sewer with large quantities

of water.
