DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

HPMTS-10 is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of industrial microbicides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act. See Technical Bulletins for directions for use.

Products containing this chemical are not to be used in the production of paper or paperboard that comes in contact with food.

#### **PRECAUTION**

##### **DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Harmful if swallowed. Severely irritating to the eyes and may cause eye damage. Avoid contact with the skin and clothing. Workmen handling the product should wear chemical resistant gloves, safety glasses or goggles and body-protective clothing. Keep the drum closed when not in use. Do not reuse the container. Dispose of the empty container in accordance with provincial requirements. **Refer to the Material Safety Data Sheet.**

#### **FIRST AID**

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**Eye Exposure:** Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 to 30 minutes or longer till irritation subsides. Do not remove contact lenses if worn. Get immediate medical attention.

**Skin Exposure:** Immediately wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

**Inhalation:** remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. If symptoms persist, call a physician.

**Ingestion:** DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Rinse mouth with copious amounts of water or milk, first. Irrigate the esophagus and dilute stomach contents by slowly giving one (1) to two (2) glasses of water or milk. Avoid giving alcohol or alcohol related products. In cases where the individual is semi-comatose, comatose or convulsing, DO NOT GIVE FLUIDS BY MOUTH. In all cases, seek IMMEDIATE medical assistance or contact the Poison Control Centre.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage.

#### **DISPOSAL**

Do not reuse this container for any purpose. This is a recyclable container, and is to be disposed of at a container

collection site. Contact your local distributor/dealer or municipality for the location of the nearest collection site. Before taking the container to the collection site:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Make the empty, rinsed container unsuitable for further use.

If there is no container collection site in your area, dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the Provincial Regulatory Agency. Contact the manufacturer and the Provincial Regulatory Agency in case of a spill, and for the clean-up of spills.
