Apply when insects or damage appear. Mix 10 mL in 2 L of water to cover 10 m2 area. Spray foliage to give thorough coverage. Repeat as needed. STRAWBERRIES - Controls Meadow Spittle Bug and Strawberry Leafroller. Mix 12 mL per L of water and spray plants thoroughly when insects or damage appear. Repeat as needed. Can be used up to one day before harvest.

ORNAMENTALS - Use on a wide range of ornamental plants, flowers, shrubs and shade trees, including rose, carnation, gladiolus, zinnia, chrysanthemum, lilac, arbor vitae, juniper, hyrangea, azalea, elm, maple, oak, dogwood, birch and pine. Do not use on Boston Ivy or Virginia Creeper.

Controls Bagworm, Birch Leafminer, Blister Beetles, Boxelder Bug, Boxwood Leafminer, Elm Leaf Aphid, Elm Leaf Beetle, Flea Beetle, Gypsy Moth, Japanese Beetle, June Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Leafrollers, Mealy Bugs, Oak Leafminers, Plant Bugs, Psyllids, Rose Aphid, Rose Slug, Scale Insects, Spruce Budworms, Tent Caterpillars, Thrips (exposed) and Willow Leaf Beetle. Use 10 mL per litre of water when insects or damage appear. Spray to give thorough coverage. Repeat weekly or as needed.
