DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Shake well before use until agitator ball rattles. Before storing after use, invert container and spray until air comes out to clear valve and spray nozzle. SPRAY IN UPRIGHT POSITION ONLY. Spray only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use as general space spray.

WHITMIRE PERMA-DUST PT 240 Residual is for use only with yellow injection tube and for injecting into cracks and crevices and void spaces where insects may be hiding, living and breeding. Place injector tip 2 cm into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings where insects may be a problem. Release approximately 1 second spray per spot. In serious infestation place spots approximately 30 cm apart. In light infestation or preventative treatment place spots approximately 1 metre apart. In long running cracks move the injector tip along the crack while spraying. Move at the rate of 30 linear cm per second in heavy infestation and 1 metre per second in light infestation. This powder spray leaves a white residue. Should misapplication occur, wipe off visible residue. See the additional directions below for effective kill of specified insects. Avoid pantry shelves and other areas where food is stored.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Cockroaches. Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, coffee makers, meter boxes and manholes. Spray directly on insects in these locations where possible. Repeat as necessary.

VOLUMETRIC TREATMENT OF INACCESSIBLE VOIDS: (false ceilings, wall voids, equipment voids and attics, crawl spaces and manholes where human contact with treated surfaces will be minimal).

For spray application with Whitmire Crack & Crevice Injection Equipment.

For exposed stages of Cockroaches. Calculate void horizontal surface area and treat at a rate of 3 seconds per square meter. Spray by placing injection tip into crack or crevice, hole or other small opening into void space. Repeat treatment as necessary.

APPLICATIONS IN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served.

APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: Do not use as general space spray. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using injection tube in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and the hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

In food processing plants use only when plant is not in operation. Remove or cover all food, food processing equipment, packaging materials and utensils before application. After application wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse with potable water before re-use for food processing.

PRECAUTIONS:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 53'C may cause bursting.

Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces. Do not spray directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, motors or into outlets and switches or any other location where the powdery residue may foul or short electric contacts and circuits.

Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
