DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Wilson Water Soluble Warfarin kills rats and mice by appealing to thirst. It is most effective for locations where there is an abundance of dry feed or limited water. Empty contents of this envelope into suitable container and add 1 litre of drinking water. No mixing or stirring required. Do not attempt to dissolve silica particles which remain in bottom of container. Wilson Water Soluble Warfarin solution should be set out where rats are accustomed to feed. In mason jars, chick founts or shallow containers, do not use water where mould or filth is noted. For mice, follow above directions but in more locations with less solution per placement. Mice are harder to

control than rats, so may take longer baiting period for control.  
Protect from children, animals and freezing.

PRECAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS AND LIVESTOCK.  
Cover with bait boxes if necessary. If swallowed by humans, pets  
or domestic animals, this material can reduce clotting ability of  
the blood.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, cause vomiting until fluid is clear.  
Call a doctor in case of accident.

TOXICOLOGY: Blood transfusions combined with intravenous  
injections and oral doses of vitamin K1 are indicated.
