DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Wood should be clean and dry, free of paint, varnish, grease or oil. Do not dilute. Apply by brush or dip 2 to 4 mins. per cm of

thickness (6 to 12 mins. for dressed lumber). Second coat may be applied for high decay hazard: allow 8 hours between coats.

Approx. coverage: 4 sq. m (43 sq. ft.) per litre.

PRECAUTION:

\* Do not apply to wood or fabrics where prolonged skin contact may occur.

\* Do not apply where the preservative may become a component of food, feed or drinking water.

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Wear gloves. Use under well-ventilated conditions. Harmful to plant life when wet.

FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS:
