BRANCHES IN PRINCIPAL CITIES

ASSAULT soil sterilant may be used for the control of most annual and perennial grasses, broad-leaved weeds and general weed control on non-crop land such as: right of ways, industrial plants lumber yards, tank farms, schools, storage areas, parking lots and similar areas.

Best results will be obtained if ASSAULT is applied shortly before or at the time plant growth begins. Thorough watering after application will cause the material to move to the root zone and thus speed up control. The effectiveness and length of time that control will last depend on type of soil, amount of rain and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: DO NOT APPLY BY AIR.

Apply ASSAULT as a spray at the rate of 550-800 litres per Hectare. (Apply 5 1/2-8 litres per 100 sq. metres.) Use low rate on sandy or light coloured soils and the high rate on clay or dark coloured soils of high organic matter content.

To control patches of harder-to-kill weeds (such as bindweed, Canada thistle, horsetail) repeat applications may be necessary.

ASSAULT should be used only in equipment recommended by your West Penetone Representative. Use only a coarse wet spray to reduce drift. For best results, excess growth may be mowed and removed before applying ASSAULT.

NOTE: Do not apply, allow to drift or drain or flush onto or near croplands, lawns, trees, or other desirable plants, or to areas where their roots may extend. Do not contaminate domestic water supplies or irrigation ditches. Do not allow contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides or seeds. Application equipment should be thoroughly cleaned after use with a detergent and water to prevent corrosion. Equipment which has been used to apply this product should not be used for applying insecticides, fungicides, fertilizers or other agricultural chemicals, as plant injury may result.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Handling the concentrate (mixing and loading): wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes, and protective eye wear (face shield or safety glasses). Rinse gloves before removal.

Coveralls or a chemical-resistant apron should also be worn when open pouring from containers greater than 5 L.

Handling the dilute spray solution (during application or repairing or cleaning equipment): wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes. Rinse gloves before removal.

Gloves are not required during application when applicator is in an enclosed tractor.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS

- Wear freshly laundered clothing and clean protective equipment daily.
- Rinse gloves before removal.

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- If herbicide penetrates clothing, remove immediately, then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Throw away clothing and other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with his product's concentrate.
- After using the product, remove clothing and launder separately, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning personal protective clothing and equipment. If no such instructions for washables are provided, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash personal protective equipment separate from household laundry.
- After work, remove all clothing and shower using soap and water.

TRANSFER SYSTEM:

For containers larger than 20 L, use a transfer system that avoids open pouring when transferring the liquid concentrate from such containers into the spray tank.

CAUTION:

Do not get on skin, in eyes or on clothing. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Avoid inhaling spray mist.

DISPOSAL:

- 1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
- 2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
- 5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately wash skin with plenty of water. In case of contact with eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention or contact a poison control centre. In case of ingestion, do not induce vomiting. Get immediate medical attention and or contact a poison control centre.
