DIRECTION FOR USE:

GENERAL: For use as crack and crevice treatment or spot treatment only. Spray surface until wet. Do not spray people, plants and pets. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

INDOOR USE: BUGCON ROACH DESTROYER kills COCKROACHES, ants, crickets, silverfish, spiders, saw-toothed grain beetles(exposed stage): Spray into cracks and crevices around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuff or house plants. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas. Do not use where food is prepared, handled or stored.

OUTDOOR USE: BUGCON ROACH DESTROYER kills COCKROACHES, ants, clovermites, crickets, fleas, millipedes, sow bugs, brown dog ticks. Spray infested areas including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not expose to temperatures over 50'C. Do not place container in hot water or near stoves or other sources of heat. Do not use near open flame or spark. Do not smoke while using. Do not spray towards eyes. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing of spray mist and use with adequate ventilation. Do not use as a space spray. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

FIRST AID: Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. If on skin, wash with soap and warm water. If in eyes, rinse with plenty of water. If irritation persists, consult a physician. If ingested, contact a physician or poison control centre immediately.

Atropine sulfate is antidotal.
