Flea and Tick Shampoo

FOR DOGS AND CATS

READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING

Flea and Tick Shampoo controls the dog and cat flea, the American dog tick and the brown dog tick as well as cleaning and deodorizing the animal.

DIRECTIONS:

Wet animal thoroughly. Apply shampoo working lather thoroughly down to skin from head to tail. Pay special attention to neck and hindquarters. Do not treat eyes, face or scrotum of pet. Allow lather to remain for 5-10 minutes. Rinse well and dry. Repeat treatments as necessary.

GUARANTEE:

Piperonyl butoxide*.....1.0%
Pyrethrins.....0.1%

(* Equivalent to 0.8% of butyl carbital (6-propyl piperonyl) ether and to 0.2% of related compounds.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Do not contaminate food or feed. Keep away from animal's eyes and mouth. Wash hands after use. Do not use on nursing females or animals under eight weeks of age. Do not use on sick animals. Do not use on animals under drug or pesticide treatment. For use on pregnant animals, consult veterinarian.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, dispose of in household garbage. Do not reuse container.

FIRST AID: If in eyes or on skin, flush with clean water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention at once.
