USE AND STORAGE DIRECTIONS FOR THE QUICK CONNECT SPRAYER:

1. Flip up (colour) spout on bottle cap. (Diagram)
2. Remove trigger sprayer from plastic bag and insert (colour) hose connector into (colour) spout on cap until it clicks in place.
3. Turn sprayer nozzle to open, and spray.
4. Adjust spray by turning nozzle to give a coarse spray.
5. Storage: After use, close nozzle on trigger sprayer and flip spout down to the "flat" position to close. No need to disconnect trigger sprayer.

NO RESIDUAL ACTIVITY IN SOIL

ROUNDUP(R), a non-selective vegetation control herbicide, controls most annual and perennial grasses, including lawn grasses, broadleaf weeds and brush (i.e. virtually anything that is green and growing). A systemic herbicide, it is absorbed by the leaves and moves throughout stem and roots to control the entire plant. Visible symptoms of control, such as browning or yellowing of leaves, will occur within 1-2 days. For best results, to ensure that Roundup gets down to the roots, avoid tillage or disturbing the treated area for 7- 10 days (or as otherwise specified on the label). This will ensure that the entire plant, including the root, is eliminated.

NOTE: ROUNDUP has no soil activity and will not leach or run off to affect nearby vegetation. Plants must be present to be controlled. Repeat applications will be required as new seedlings and vegetation emerge.
