#### **HOW TO USE:**

**BULB PLANTING TREATMENT:** Before planting, shake a small quantity of **Later's Bulb Dust** directly into the planting hole. To treat a large area, broadcast the **Bulb Dust** at the rate of 250 g over a 5 m<sup>2</sup> surface area and work into the soil in a depth of 8 cm.  $(5 \text{ m}^2 = 5 \text{ long paces by } 1 \text{ long pace}).$ 

**STORAGE TREATMENT:** Before storing bulbs or corms for winter, place the dry and clean bulbs in a plastic bag with a small quantity of **Later's Bulb Dust** and shake the bag to cover the bulbs with a light protective covering of dust. Prevents Bulb Rot during storage.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Never handle material with bare hands. Use rubber gloves; do not use leather or cloth gloves. Wash hands, face and arms thoroughly after handling and before drinking, eating or smoking. Do not breathe dust. When handling, wear goggles and clothing that completely covers arms and legs to minimize exposure. Change contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse. If an accident occurs, remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash contaminated skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash clothing and gloves before reuse. Always work out of the wind when handling, or applying treatments. Keep unprotected persons out of the operating area or vicinity where there may be a drift.

**FIRST AID:** In case of poisoning call a physician or poison control centre immediately. **IF SWALLOWED,** give the patient one or two glasses of water and cause vomiting by giving one dose of syrup of ipecac. If the patient does not vomit within 20 minutes, give a second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, give the patient one or two glasses of water and cause vomiting by inserting a finger down the throat. Repeat with water until vomit fluid is clear. The patient should be lying down with the head below the level of the feet. DO NOT TRY TO CAUSE VOMITING IF THE PATIENT IS UNSCONIOUS OR IN A CONVULSIVE STATE. **IF IN EYES,** flush with water for 5-10 minutes and get medical attention. **IF ON SKIN,** remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Reg. No. with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Carbaryl is a moderate cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

**STORAGE:** Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in household garbage.
