DIRECTIONS: Apply a light, even coat of dust to all surface areas of the plant.

POTATOES: For the control of Early and Late Blight, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle and Leaf Hoppers, dust leaf surfaces. Make first application when plants are 15-20 cm high and repeat every seven to ten days or as necessary. Do not apply within seven days of harvest.

TOMATOES: For the control of Early and Late Blight, Hornworm, Fruit Worm and Flea Beetles, dust leaf surfaces. Make first application three weeks after planting and repeat every seven to ten days or as necessary. Do not apply within one day of harvest.

NOTE: Do not use this product during pollination period.

Carbaryl is very toxic to bees.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin. Do not take internally. Wash thoroughly after handling. Change contaminated clothing daily. Store container in cool dry ventilated place.

FIRST AID: In case of poisoning call a physician immediately or contact a Poison Control Centre. If in eyes flush with water 5 - 10 minutes. If swallowed, give the patient one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting. Do not induce vomiting if patient is unconscious or in a convulsive state.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and discard in household garbage.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Carbaryl is a moderate Cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
