DIRECTIONS

Ultra-Fresh DM-50N is a water and solvent dispersible liquid concentrate that can be padded into fabrics, incorporated into adhesives, or added to latex emulsions to give protection against fungal and bacterial degradation. For padding operations the bath concentration should be adjusted to give a 0.2% to 0.4% fabric pick-up, depending on the degree of biological protection desired. With adhesives and latex emulsions an addition of 0.08% by weight is recommended for preservations.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER – Fatal or poisonous if swallowed, corrosive to eyes and skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear goggles or face shield and chemical resistant gloves when handling. Not for use in materials that are likely to have food contact. FIRST AID
