DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Later's Chickweed, Clover & Thistle Killer is a concentrated weedkiller for lawns. When mixed with water it will control unsightly choking weeds including White Clover, Chickweed, Buttercup, Cornspurry, Plantain, Canada Thistle and Stitchwort. It will not harm lawn grass when used as directed. Apply anytime weeds are actively growing. Application made in spring and fall when the weeds are small and the temperature is low are the most effective. Safe to use on bent grass, red fescue and rye grasses. Do not apply to bent grass when temperature is above 23°C. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. Spray entire lawn wetting weeds and lawn grasses. Do not water for 48 hours after application. Newly seeded lawns may be treated after they have been mowed at least 3 times.

5 mL = 1 teaspoon 1 m = approx. 1 step
15 mL = 1 tablespoon 50 m² = 10 m x 5 m

HOW TO USE:

SPRING APPLICATION: Mix 30 mL with 5 L of water and spray to cover 50 m².

FALL APPLICATION: Mix 45 mL with 5 L of water and spray to cover 50 m².

Maximum Application Frequency: For good lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Keep children and pets away from treated areas, at least until spray has dried. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing.
