INDOOR USE: Thoroughly treat cracks, crevices, baseboards, underneath furniture and equipment, around garbage containers, localized areas (spot treatment only) of floors and floor coverings and other places where insects habitate.

OUTDOOR USE: Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, light fixtures and other places where spiders may alight or congregate and enter.

DIRECTIONS: Hold container approximately 30 cm. from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications produce a coating which will vaporize into cracks and crevices for spider control. If reinfestation occurs, repeat applications. Provide adequate ventilation after indoor use.
