1. Water Purification - Add daily to maintain .6 - 1.0 parts per million of residual available chlorine (PPM CL₂). Daily charge depends upon air temperature and number of people in the pool

Algae - Add 380 mL for every 10,000 L of water and circulate for at least 8 hours. If algae persists, superchlorinate by twice amount normally used. Do not use pool until available chlorine has fallen to 2.0 PPM CL₂. Wading Pools - Add 5 mL for every 250 L of water daily.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not mix with toilet bowl cleaners, rust removers, household ammonia or acids.

FIRST AID TREATMENT: Contains Sodium Hypochlorite. If splashed in eyes or on skin, flush thoroughly with water. If swallowed, give one or two glasses of milk or warm water. Call physician

immediately. Keep patient warm.

STORAGE: Keep out of sunlight and store in a cool place.
