Emulsifiable concentrates may make dispersion of FREEDOM™ WSB 75DF Herbicide more difficult. For that reason, tank heels of the previous tank mix should be kept to 10% or less of the spray tank volume.
- 6. Do not allow the spray mixture to remain in the tank for more than 24 hours before spraying or the effectiveness may be reduced. If the spray mixture has been allowed to stand in the tank, use vigorous agitation to thoroughly disperse before resuming spraying.

7. Use the spray preparation of FREEDOM™ WSB 75DF Herbicide within 24 hours or product degradation may occur. If spray solution is left standing without agitation, thoroughly agitate and re-suspend any settled FREEDOM™ WSB 75DF Herbicide before resuming the spraying operation.

NOTE: Do not mix the soluble bags with fertilizers, substances that contain boron or substances that release free chlorine. Mixing the water soluble bags with any of these compounds will result in an insoluble substance in the tank.

EQUIPMENT-SPRAY VOLUMES

Apply the spray mixture uniformly with properly calibrated ground equipment only. Ensure thorough coverage and a uniform spray pattern. Flat fan nozzles are recommended (minimum 100 litres spray volume per hectare). When using flood jet or "Raindrop" nozzles, apply 225 litres per hectare total spray volume to ensure thorough coverage. Use 50 mesh filter screens or larger (metal or nylon).

Continuous agitation is required to keep FREEDOM™ WSB 75DF Herbicide in suspension. Apply uniformly and avoid overlapping. Shut off spray boom while starting, turning, slowing or stopping to prevent crop injury from over application.

SPRAYER CLEANUP

To avoid subsequent injury to crops other than wheat, barley, oats, Imazethapyr tolerant canola (e.g. canola varieties with the SMART trait), or CDC Triffid flax immediately after spraying and prior to spraying other crops thoroughly remove all traces of FREEDOM $^{\text{M}}$ WSB 75DF Herbicide from mixing and spray equipment as follows:

- 1. Drain tank and flush tank, boom and hoses with clean water for a minimum of ten minutes. Visually inspect tank to assure removal of all visible residues of FREEDOM™ WSB 75DF Herbicide. If necessary, repeat step 1. DO NOT CLEAN SPRAYER NEAR WELL OR WATER SOURCE OR NEAR TO DESIRABLE VEGETATION.
- 2. Fill tank with clean water while adding 1 litre household ammonia (containing a minimum 3% ammonia) per 100 litres of water. Flush solution through boom and hoses, and then add more water to completely fill tank. Allow to sit for 15 minutes with agitation. Again flush the hoses, boom and nozzles with the cleaning solution and drain tank.

- 3. Remove the nozzles and screens and clean separately in a bucket containing cleaning agent and water.
- 4. Repeat Step 2.
- 5. Thoroughly rinse the tank with clean water for a minimum of 5 minutes, flushing water through the hoses and boom.

CAUTION: Do not use ammonia with chlorine bleach. Using ammonia with chlorine bleach will release a gas with a musty chlorine odour which may cause eye, nose, throat, and lung irritation. Do not clean equipment in an enclosed area.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply to wheat, barley, oats, Imazethapyr tolerant canola (e.g. canola varieties with the SMART $^{\mathbb{M}}$ trait), or CDC Triffid flax that are or have been stressed prior to application by severe weather conditions (including frost or drought), low fertility, water saturated soil, disease or insect damage as crop injury may result. Do not apply to registered crops if the above stress conditions are expected within 3 days after application as crop injury may result.

Do not apply within 15 metres of a body of water or wetland area.

Do not apply to irrigated land where tail water will be used to irrigate crop land. Do not contaminate irrigation water.
