DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. For pools with no visible algae, protect pool against algae growths by adding 150 mL per 10,000 litres of water, of

Winter Time Algaecide around edges of pool.

2. For pools with visible algae present add 250 mL of Winter Time Algaecide around edges of pool. Circulate pool water for six hours before hibernization.

For Covered Pools: Apply appropriate dosage according to directions, as shown above, dependent upon whether algae is visibole in the pool.

For Uncovered Pools: Apply appropriate dosage according to directions, as shown above, dependent upon whether algae is visible in the pool. Follow this throughout the winter months, with maintenance addition of 35 mL per 10,000 litres every week.
