DIRECTIONS

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK & CREVICE
TREATMENT, IS NOT PERMITTED.

Use a small putty knife or similar tool to STIR PRODUCT IF
NEEDED, then use same tool, or a Bait Applicator, to apply

approximately 28 grams per 10 square metres, applying the paste liberally in heavily infested areas and sparingly in lightly infested areas in Homes, Restaurants and other food and feed handling establishments, Motels, Hotels, Hospitals, Offices, Nursing Homes, new construction, Industrial Plants, Yachts, Theaters, Trains, Boats, Ships, Libraries, Camps, Mobile Homes, Zoos, Kennels.

Apply the paste into the seams, under and behind refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, sinks dryers, tubs and washing machines; into openings around drains, conduits, sewers, sewer pipes, and manholes.

Apply paste in cracks and crevices, in corners of cabinets, cupboards, food closets, and along baseboards. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom closets, bedroom dressers, chests of drawers, and apply paste into each corner of the drawer wells.

ANY PASTE VISIBLE AFTER APPLICATION MUST BE SCRAPED INTO CRACKS AND CREVICES OR REMOVED.

APPLY THE PASTE IN AREAS INACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN AND PETS.

IN NON-FOOD AREAS, Including garbage rooms, lavatories, offices locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, storage areas(after canning or bottling): Apply to baseboard areas, around waterpipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets, and similar areas where Cockroaches hide or through which they may enter.

IN FOOD PROCESSING AND MEAT PACKING PLANTS,(Including those that are Federally inspected): Apply only when plant is not in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials to be left in the room. Cover food handling equipment. Any treated surface that may contact meat or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after application and before re-use for food processing.

NEW CONSTRUCTION: Apply the paste liberally when treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place. Do NOT store at extreme temperatures.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid contact with damaged or broken skin. May cause skin irritation. Wash thoroughly after handling.

FIRST AID:

EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, consult Physician.

SKIN: Flush with water.

INGESTION: Drink large amounts of water or milk. Induce vomiting by inserting finger into mouth and touching back of throat. Consult a Physician or Poison Control Center.
