DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For slime (bacterial and fungal) control in pulp, paper and paperboard mills, use 0.025 to 0.5 kg of Nalcon 7619 Microbiological Control Chemical per 1,000 kg of pulp or paper, dry basis, depending upon degree of contamination. Nalcon 7619 Microbiological Control Chemical may be added anywhere in the system prior to the sheet forming area or in the recirculating white water system. This product is not to be used in the production of paper or paperboard that comes into contact with food. For general non-pulp and paper process recirculating applications use 100-200 ppm, based upon system volume. For specific process recirculating water systems in the fiberglass insulation industry, apply 100-200 ppm into the process water flow to the sump from the collector.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER. CORROSIVE TO EYES & SKIN. POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER. Nalcon 7619 Microbiological Control Chemical is corrosive to eyes and skin and may cause severe skin and eye damage. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. May be harmful if absorbed through skin. May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Wear a full-face NIOSH approved respirator, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, shoes plus socks and a chemical-resistant apron during mixing/loading, clean up, and repair activities. Users should wash hands

before eating, drinking, chewing gum, and when using tobacco or the toilet. Users should remove clothing/protective equipment immediately if this product comes in contact with the skin through soaked clothing or spills.
