READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING

To maintain product quality, store at temperatures below 35°C. Keep package tightly closed when not in use.

DIRECTIONS:

Add PROCESS B 2013 separately to the system. Do not mix it with other additives in order to avoid decomposition of PROCESS B 2013 due to the high pH of many additive formulations.

PULP AND PAPER MILLS:

Additions of PROCESS B 2013 may be continuous or intermittent, depending on the type of system and the severity of contamination. It should be made with a metering pump at a location that will ensure uniform distribution of PROCESS B 2013 in the mass of fibre and water such as the beaters, Jordan inlet or discharge, broke chests, furnish chests, save-alls, and white water tanks. Moderately to heavily fouled systems should be boiled out prior to treatment as dislodged slime may cause breaks in paper.

DOSAGE: Add 250-625 ml of PROCESS B 2013 per tonne of paper (dry basis) on a continuous or intermittent basis as necessary to maintain control.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
