DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apply DMR-23 DISINFECTANT with a cloth or mop. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

FOR DISINFECTION OF POTATO WAREHOUSES AND EQUIPMENT - To control corneybacterium sepedonicum/ring rot, add 6.7 mL DMR-23 DISINFECTANT to 1 litre water after thorough cleaning. After disinfection, ventilate buildings and closed spaces. All treated equipment must be rinsed with potable water before reuse.
