The patient should be lying down with the head below the level of the feet. Do not try to cause vomiting if the patient is unconscious or in a convulsive state.

May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of dust. Wash hands and face after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Treat seed in a well ventilated area. Wear coveralls over normal work clothing and chemical resistant gloves when handling APRON COMBI FS, contaminated equipment or APRON COMBI FS treated seed. Do not consume alcoholic beverages immediately before or within 24 hours of working with APRON COMBI FS.

DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL:

- 1. In cleaning of equipment or disposing of wastes, do not contaminate water used for human or animal consumption or by wildlife and aquatic life or for irrigation purposes.
- 2. Empty container thoroughly into the mixing tank.
- 3. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and dispose of the rinsings in accordance with provincial requirements.
- 4. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.

GENERAL INFORMATION: APRON COMBI FS is a ready to-use flowable formulation containing metalaxyl, thiabendazole, and thiram for protection against <u>Ascochyta</u>, downy mildew and seedling "damping-off" diseases in peas. Do not dilute with water. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Dose

5 litres APRON COMBI FS per tonne (1000 KG) of seed. (One 20 litre jug will treat 4 tonnes [4000 KG] of seed).

Method of Application

APRON COMBI FS should be applied through continuous flow seed treaters. Adequate seed coverage is obtained if APRON COMBI FS is added at the start of the conveyer or mixing process.

It is essential that any continuous flow seed treatment equipment be calibrated for APRON COMBI FS before commercial use.

Volume

APRON COMBI FS is a ready-to-use formulation which should NOT be diluted further. It should be applied to seed using a volume of 500 mL of APRON COMBI FS per 100 kg of seed (5 L/tonne)

Storage after Treatment

Ensure that the seeds are of a satisfactory moisture content before storage; keep in a dry place, correctly labelled. Treated seed should be coloured and labelled: "FOR EXPORT ONLY. This seed has been treated with metalaxyl, thiabendazole and thiram fungicides. Poisonous to man and animals. Do not use for feed or food purposes. Store away from feeds and foodstuffs".
