DIRECTIONS: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold can upright while spraying.

FOR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR USE:

HOUSE PESTS: Flying Insects: Kills flies, gnats, mosquitoes,

hornets, wasps, whiteflies and small flying moths. Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources where insects are present. Apply 6-10 seconds burst per 30m3 of space. Keep spray at least 1 m from interior wall, fabrics and furniture. Spray around light fixtures. Vacate for at least 15 minutes after each treatment and aerate before re-entering.

FOR USE IN GARAGES & COVERED SCREENED PATIOS: Direct spray towards ceiling or rafters using a sweeping motion. Apply 6-10 seconds burst per 30 m3 of space. Keep garage closed for 15 minutes. Vacate for at least 15 minutes after each treatment and aerate before re-entering.

HOUSE PLANTS PESTS: Kills ants, aphids, caterpillars, leaf hoppers, spiders, whiteflies, mealybugs and spider mites on house plants such as English Ivy, Impatiens, Geraniums and Begonias. Hold container 45 cm to 60 cm from plants being sprayed. Cover upper and lower surfaces of leaves. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Use short bursts of one second for spot application on new growth. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.

OUTDOOR GARDEN PESTS: Kills aphids, japanese beetles, ants, caterpillars, exposed thrips, leafhoppers, spidermites, whiteflies, mealybugs, and eastern tent caterpillars on outdoor flower and ornamental plants such as Roses, Chrysanthemums, Azalea, Geraniums, Peonies, Dahlias, Carnations, Gladioli, Asters, Camellias, Delphiniums, other flowering plants, Evergreens and Deciduous Shrubs. Hold container 45 to 60 cm from plants being sprayed. Cover upper and lower surfaces of leaves. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Use short bursts of one second for spot application on new growth. Spray preferably in early morning or evening when air is still to avoid drifting. Do not spray when temperature is over 30 degrees C.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50 deg C. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In homes or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Vacate room for at least 15 minutes after spraying, and aerate before re-entering. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on MaidenHair ferns, fruit and vegetable crops.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of empty container with household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.

FIRST AID: In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention or call Poison Control Centre immediately.
