DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product has been specifically developed for use on horses. When used as directed, it provides a protective hair coating against biting and nuisance flies. This product may also be used as a spray in horse barns for quick knock down and kill of flies and mosquitoes.

HORSES:

To Wipe On: Brush horse's hair before application to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten a soft cloth with FLY KILL SPRAY OR WIPE ON and briskly run cloth over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, flanks, shoulders, neck and area around the face where flies generally are seen. Once applied, do not wet skin. Apply 50 – 100 mL on mature horses and 25 – 50 mL on ponies. Repeat daily or as required. Do not allow solution to contact animal's eyes, mouth or any wounds.

To Use As A Spray: May be applied directly to the horse as a fine mist spray. Spray horses once daily applying just enough spray to wet the hair ends. Apply 50 – 100 mL on horses and 25 – 50 mL on ponies. Do not spray on the face of animal (wipe on face).

HORSE STABLE AND BARN:

Remove all animals from quarters before spraying. Close doors and windows. Wear mask or respirator and protective clothing when applying spray mist. Spray with a hand sprayer onto areas where mosquitoes and other flies congregate. For space spray, direct spray upwards and away from applicator to fill room. Keep barn or stable area closed for 10 – 20 minutes after spraying. Ventilate area thoroughly before humans or horses re-enter. Do not contaminate feed or water troughs. Do not spray over milk or milking equipment.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid breathing spray mist. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not contaminate feed, water or food stuffs. Do not cover horses immediately after treatment. Do not use on horses intended for slaughter. Remove animals from quarters before treating premises and ventilate area thoroughly before re-admitting animals.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. If vomiting occurs spontaneously, keep victim's head below hips to prevent the breathing of vomitus into lungs. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If in eyes, Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD:

Toxic to fish. Do not apply this product directly to aquatic habitats (such as lakes, rivers, sloughs, ponds, prairie potholes, creeks, marshes, streams, reservoirs, ditches and wetlands), estuaries or marine habitats. Do not contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes.

DISPOSAL:
