DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 100 mL of Algea 40 per 10,000 L of pool water.

- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 35 mL per 10,000 L.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of POOL-SHOCK and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 150 mL of Algea 40 per 10,000 L.
