DIRECTIONS: Dust liberally over the animal beginning at the head and working back. Be sure that the powder gets down to the skin, including feet and legs. To prevent reinfestation, applications should be repeated at weekly intervals as needed. Also, dust animal bedding and sleeping quarters. Wash hands after use.

FIRST AID: If in eyes or on skin, flush with water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If swallowed,

induce vomiting and go to hospital.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with the dog's eyes. Harmful if inhaled or swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust and contact with skin. Do not treat dogs under 8 weeks of age. Do not use on nursing females. Do not use on sick dogs and dogs under drug or pesticide treatment. Consult veterinarian for use on pregnant animals. Repeated application may produce skin or nasal irritation in sensitive cats. If this occurs discontinue use. Do not use near birds, fish, feed or foodstuff.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage.
