NATURE OF RESTRICTION - This product is to be stored apart from
lodging for humans, animal quarters, and normal work areas, to
avoid inadvertent exposure.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO OPEN THIS CONTAINER: The contents of this can are under
pressure. Hold firmly in upright position. Open only with
specially designed applicator. Use no other device. Information

on this equipment will be furnished upon request.

FUMIGATION PROCEDURE: For control of nematodes, quackgrass and seeds of certain weeds apply 5 to 10 Kg of Methyl Bromide MC2 per 100m² of tobacco plant bed. For control of damping off organisms apply 10 Kg/100m². Plow furrow around area to be fumigated. Place evaporator pans 9 m apart and fasten ends of tubing to each pan leading to outer edge of bed. After supports are in place gasproof cover should be laid with edges in furrow and sealed with earth. Minimum exposure period is 24 to 48 hours at 21°C. Aerate soil before planting. Stir up soil to ensure ventilation. Do not fumigate if soil temperature is less than 10°C. Do not set out plants in treated soil for at least one week after fumigation. Consult United Agri Products for full information on specific applicators, dosages, procedures and safety equipment.

WELL-ROTTED COMPOST, MANURE, TOP SOIL, POTTING SOIL: Apply outdoors or in well-ventilated indoor locations. Treat loose moist material with a temperature above 15°C. Support the cover a few cm above the pile and introduce the chemical at the highest point. Fumigate for 24 hours. Aerate for 72 hours. Use 250 mL of fumigant per cubic metre.

FIRST AID

In case of contact remove all contaminated clothing including shoes and bandages. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water and flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

If inhaled remove patient to open area. Keep patient lying down and warm, with head slightly below level of body. If necessary give artificial respiration. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. Administer oxygen or stimulant, only under supervision of a physician.

PRECAUTIONS

Danger: Extremely hazardous vapors highly volatile: Causes Burns. Do not breathe vapor. Poisonous to all animal life. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Remove shoes or clothing immediately if liquid is spilled on them, otherwise severe blistering will result. Keep container away from heat. STORE IN COOL, WELL VENTILATED PLACE, AWAY FROM DWELLINGS - OPEN ONLY WITH SPECIAL APPLICATOR - HOLD FIRMLY IN UPRIGHT POSITION

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Symptoms of Poisoning: Paralysis, weakness of extremities, dizziness, blurred vision, lassitude, sensation of profound fatigue, slurring speech, nausea, vomiting, anorexia, abdominal pain. Overwhelming exposure may result in respiratory embarrassment and/or cardiac failure; pneumonia.

Antidote and Treatment: Treat symptomatically. If there is evidence of cardiac and/or circulatory embarrassment, one of the hypotensive drugs may be indicated. In case of pulmonary embarrassment, oxygen may be necessary. If pulmonary irritation and pneumonia result, treat with antibiotics and other measures appropriate to this ailment. Any patient suspected of Methyl Bromide poisoning, should be kept under observation for at least 48 hours.

DISPOSAL:

1. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
2. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
3. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
4. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the clean-up of spills contact the regional office of the Conservation and Protection Service, Environment Canada.
