A SELECTIVE CONTROL OF SUSCEPTIBLE BROADLEAF WEEDS FOR LAWNS, such as Dandelion, Black Medic*, Catsear, Ground Ivy, Knotweed, Mallow*, Plantain and Mustard.

*Controls young stage only.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Greenleaf Dandelion Weedkiller Solution is concentrated. When mixed with water and when used as directed, it will not harm lawn grass. For best results, apply when weeds are actively growing and weather is warm in spring, summer and fall. Do not cut grass for 4 days before and after treatment. Do not use during long, excessively dry or hot period (over 29°C). Do not apply when rain is expected. Do not water lawn within 24 hours of application. Spray evenly and thoroughly. Repeat as necessary. **Maximum Application Frequency:** For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot

treatments. Newly seeded lawns may be treated after they have been mowed at least 3 times.

HOW TO USE: Mix 5 mL of this product with 5 litres of water to cover 10 m². Apply evenly over lawn or apply as a spot treatment.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation and contact with eyes, skin and clothing.

Protective Clothing: Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, and chemical-resistant (e.g., rubber) gloves.

Operator Use Precautions: Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Re-use gloves for pesticide application only.

Re-entry Interval: Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not contaminate streams, lakes, or ponds. Avoid spray drift onto desirable plants as spray could injure cultivated species. Bent grass may be injured or killed. Do not use same sprayer for other purposes.

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, induce vomiting and contact a doctor or poison control centre at once. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF IN EYES, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. IF ON SKIN, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

STORAGE: Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place away from food, feed, seeds, fertilizer, insecticides or fungicides. Do not store diluted spray.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use container. Rinse thoroughly and use rinse-water with regular spray. Wrap container in newspaper and dispose of in regular garbage.
