DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Information: Propaturf is a specially formulated herbicide for golf course fairways and roughs, sod farms, grass areas in parks and parklands, and also in non-crop areas. Propaturf should not be used on Bentgrass.

Method of Application: The weeds listed below are most susceptible in May, June and September (in coastal areas of B.C.,

also in April and October). The effectiveness of a treatment in July and August depends on general weather conditions. If it is hot and dry during that period, a second treatment may be necessary. If it rains within 24 hours after spraying, a repeat application may be required. Newly seeded areas should not be sprayed within 4 weeks after grass emergence and then only at half the recommended rate for the first month.

Rate of Application: Use 3.5 litres of Propaturf in 200-500 litres of water per hectare. The amount of water needed to cover one hectare depends on the spray equipment and is not important, provided it is not less than 200 L/ha.

Poison Ivy: can be controlled with Propaturf at the rate of 1 litre per 100 litres of water. Spray thoroughly until the foliage drips. The best results are obtained when applied between mid-June and late July. A repeat treatment in the following year may be necessary.
