DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply Safer's Insecticidal Soap Hose-End Spray using the hose-end applicator provided (attached). Applicator will accurately dilute this concentrated insecticide for treatment of vegetables, flowers, fruits, shrubs, trees.

- 1. Read the complete label for application instructions and precautions.
- 2. Connect spray applicator provided to garden hose.
- 3. Remove bottle cap and attach bottle to applicator.
- 4. Turn ON/OFF switch on top of applicator to OFF position (sideways).
- 5. Turn on water on tap.
- 6. When ready to spray, point sprayer towards target and turn ON/OFF switch to centre ON position.

7. When spraying is complete, turn ON/OFF switch to OFF position, then turn water off. Disconnect applicator from water hose.

CAUTION: Rate of delivery of product will vary depending on water pressure, location, time of day, length and diameter of hose, etc. Complete contents of container (550 mL) can be sprayed in approximately 2-4 minutes.
