DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For controlling algae in industrial and farm ponds, dissolve the product in water and apply to the water surface as a spray, at the rate of 6.5-9.0 kg per hectare in water bodies with a depth of 1 meter. This will result in a concentration of copper sulphate of 0.5-0.7 mg/L. The rate should be adjusted according to the depth of the water.

NATURE OF RESTRICTION:

This product may be used only in the manner authorized; contact local pesticide regulatory authorities about use permits which may be required.

RESTRICTED USES

WHERE TO APPLY:

Cuprose can be used for control of algae in municipal water supply reservoirs (bodies of water that may be used as potable water source, but before it is purified for drinking purpose). Do not apply or allow discharge to lakes, flowing water or ponds with outflow. Do not apply to areas frequented by wildlife.

HOW TO APPLY:

Dissolve the product in water and apply to the water surface as a spray, at the rate of 6.5-9.0 kg per hectare in water bodies with a depth of 1 meter. These rates will result in a concentration of copper sulphate of approximately 0.5-0.7 mg/L. Adjust the application rate in accordance with the depth of water.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Cuprose can cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid eye contact. This material is abrasive, may cause severe eye damage if not treated immediately by flushing eyes with water for at least 20 minutes. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear goggles and rubber gloves when handling.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

FIRST AID:
