DIRECTIONS: "Use on portable sprayers or fogging machines"
SURFACE TREATMENT: Treat surface areas at the rate of 6.7 L/100 SQ M. Apply coarse spray, moving spray rapidly to avoid over-wetting.

FLYING INSECTS: close doors and windows. Using a portable sprayer, direct spray-mist upwards to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources. Also direct spray mist into areas where insects are present. Start with the farthest corner of the room and finish at doorway. For fogging machines, set sprayer to distribute 200 mL / 100 cu. m and apply at a rate of 170 mL per minute. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15-20 minutes after each treatment. Ventilate treated areas for at least 30 minutes before re-entry.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails around door sills, window frame, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed. Apply at a rate of 6.7 L / 100 cu. m. Apply a coarse spray moving the spray rapidly to prevent over-wetting.

BEDBUGS: Spray mattress, particularly around seams and tufts. Take bed apart, spray all joints. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated.

PRECAUTIONS: Flammable mixture. Product contains petroleum distillates. Do not store, pour or use near a fire or flame. Wear mask or respirator when applying spray mist. Wear protective clothing. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating etc. Do not contaminate feed, water or food stuffs; in food processing plants and food service establishments, apply only when plant is not in operation. Remove all food before treatment. Cover all food processing surfaces and thoroughly clean with potable water before resuming operation. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Remove fishbowls, bird cages, pets before treatment. Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces. Do not spray closer than 90 cm to fabric.

FIRST AID: If swallowed DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY. If product contact skin, wash with soap and water. In case of contact with eyes, flush with plenty of water. If eye or skin irritation persists, seek medical attention
